



NANA REGIONAL CORPORATION LANDS DEPARTMENT POLICIES

Aircraft Policies

All aircraft downed on NANA lands must be removed at the owner's expense.

Owners of airplanes downed on NANA lands are required to notify NANA of the planes location within 72 hours of the accident and obtain a permit from the NANA land department for the plane's timely removal.

NANA may waive the requirement for removal of downed aircraft if removal would cause unacceptable resource damage or cause threats to human life.

Aircraft not removed by the owner after proper notification become NANA property.

No aircraft or aircraft parts may be removed from NANA lands without a permit from the NANA land department.
